The cash deposit must be conditioned on the prosecution of the appeal and the payment of any judgment and all costs ordered. Rule 510.9, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure. Within 5 days of filing the appeal bond, the Defendant/Tenant must serve written notice of the appeal on the Plaintiff/Landlord.
